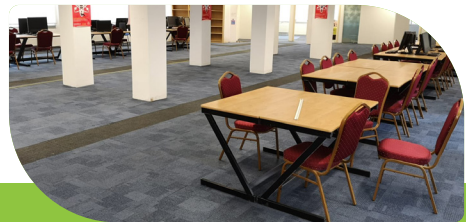
## About UK Sustainable Flooring Alliance

UKSFA is an independent non-profit membership organisation working with the supply chain to increase sustainability within the flooring industry and reduce the volume of textile and resilient flooring waste being sent to landfill and work towards a circular economy.

Initially set up as Carpet Recycling UK in 2008 by industry leaders, the aim was to foster strategic collaborations and networks to develop viable solutions for carpet and other textile flooring waste. Under our new name of UK Sustainable Flooring Association; we continue this work but now span both the textile and resilient flooring supply chain and waste recovery sector. As UKSFA we support our members to take advantage of emerging opportunities in the recycling of textile and resilient flooring, including sustainable raw materials for manufacture, reuse of products, take back schemes and identifying recycling outlets nationwide, or innovations in material processing.

With a membership of over 120 companies, our current Core Members are flooring manufacturers and distributors who are taking voluntary producer responsibility on sustainability. These are Balsan, Brintons, Condor Group, Cormar Carpets, ege Carpets, Furlong Flooring, Gradus, Headlam Group, Likewise Floors, Milliken, Modulyss, Mohawk Group, Shaw, Tarkett and Victoria Group.

The Core Members are strategic supporters of UKSFA, working together to help us disseminate latest information to, and represent the flooring industry in the UK, EU and international marketplace.

- Influence environmental legislation and promote the sector to policy makers.
- Disseminate industry developments at conferences, trade events and exhibitions.
- Initiate, coordinate and publish research to support circularity and sustainability best practice.
- Report on performance of the sector through surveys and annual data analysis.
- Support and promote members' environmental and sustainable achievements.

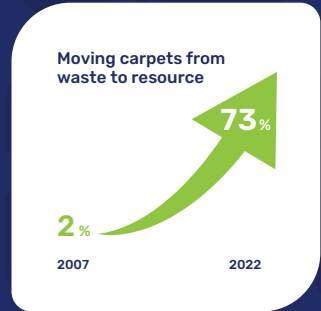

## How we are making a difference

- Between 2008 and 2025, UKSFA (Formerly Carpet Recycling UK) helped industry divert over 1.7m tonnes of carpet and textile flooring materials and waste from landfill.
- Helped flooring manufacturers to reduce production waste and save on cost.
- Supporting and promoting circular design and products using more recycled content.
- Regularly publishing and promoting articles in known industry publications to raise awareness of members' sustainable products and achievements.
- Updating our international network through monthly e-newsletters and social media presence.
- Advising on segregation and compaction of flooring waste to make recycling collections feasible.
- Helping flooring suppliers to segregate fitting offcuts for the manufacture of felt based products such as underlay and growing felt.
- Through best practice guidance, helping companies to divert carpet tiles into reuse projects.
- Supporting manufacturers to help their customers use commercial flooring waste as a resource.
- Supporting UKSFA Core Members to facilitate take-back, reuse and recycling.
